


WARNINGS - Prior To Drilling

- Improper drilling can cause property damage to vehicles and could lead to electric shock, fire, or even death.
- Ensure that drilling is only performed on areas of the vehicle allowed by the vehicle's Original Equipment Manufacturer's Body Builders Layout Book (or equivalent document).
- Ensure that you will not hit any critical parts of the vehicle like the gas tank, wiring harnesses, or hoses. Consult the vehicle's OEM documentation as necessary. When drilling, use a drill collar to reduce the risk of damage to the vehicle.



WARNINGS - Prior To Operating Vehicle

The heaviest items must be placed towards the bottom of the vehicle, while the lightest ones can be arranged upwards. Vehicle cargo loading weight proportion should follow the guidelines shown here.



- Check your vehicle's tare weight and remaining load capacity with all equipment installed. Never exceed the maximum Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), Gross Axle Weight Ratings (GAWRs), or other maximum loads permitted by the vehicle's Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) and required by law.

- All system components should be regularly inspected, cleaned, and maintained pursuant to Ranger Design quidelines.


2.1.1 Remove all the D-rings and set aside for future setps.

2.2.1 Place guide-pin & spacers in marked locations.






Guide pin (90-023) does not need to be fully threaded. This is to prevent the spacers from moving when installing the floor.






